IT Leadership

Jim Collins in his book 'From Good to Great' identified that the way great companies used technology was a major factor in their differentiation and success. But, to manage technology successfully, IT professionals need to master over 50 different key skills.

So where is the IT manager to spend his time to be of most value? Determining the right priorities is critical to the success of any senior IT executive. And the short average time that IT managers spend in the job suggest that many get it wrong. The principles of emotional intelligence and how to successfully apply them to leading IT organizations are covered. 
