Nahil also championed the ISMS27001 project at MCB Bank, and during his time, the first-ever database security project in Pakistan was successfully installed at a financial institution in the country.

Nahil also put together one of the largest and most effective Information Security teams and has been nominated for a number of regional awards based on his significant contribution to Information Security in the country.

Nahil has also held senior positions at IBM Pakistan, Wateen Telecom, and WorldCALL Telecom Group. He is recognized for playing a pioneering role for introduction of latest broadband technology in the country while deploying multi-million dollar, cutting-edge technology projects. He also holds the coveted Cisco Certified Internetwork Expert (CCIE) Certification which he secured after a lab exam in Dubai in 2008.
